Please Note:

The daily cost for the bus service is \$17.50 per child. Due to the high cost of the service and the burden this place on families, the school is subsidising the cost at the rate of \$12.50 per day per child with families paying \$5 per day per child. The subsidy is provided under the strict condition that parents pay their contribution to the bus service on a timely basis and are not in arrears with their payment.

Payment Conditions

- Transport fees will need to be paid in full at the beginning of Term 1 unless payment agreement has been made with the school. Paying in full secures a seat to travel to and from school.
- The above fees are set fees. If a child is absent from school, no refund will be issued.

Terms and conditions of travel

- Students to ensure no belongings are always left inside the bus .
- No items will be thrown from a bus window or have anything hanging out a window.
- Get on and off the bus quietly and in an orderly manner.
- Stay in the seat while bus is moving.
- When getting off the bus only cross the road when the bus has left, and it is safe to do so.
- In the morning, arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes prior to departure.
- Students are not allowed to eat or drink while on the bus.
- Should part of the bus be damaged due to child(ren) actions the parent will be notified and liable for all damages.

Responsibilities of Parent / Caregivers

- Parents/Caregivers are responsible for transporting their children to and from authorised bus stops and their safety at the bus stop while waiting for the bus.
- It is most important that parents waiting for bus passengers at a roadside bus stop should wait on the same side of the road as the bus to prevent accidents.

- Transportation fees are not negotiable and must be paid by the due date.
