This application is to be completed and signed by the Parent/Caregiver of students applying to travel on the school bus to attend either St Hurmizd Assyrian Primary School or St Narsai Assyrian Christian College. This service assumes that students will be travelling two ways on the bus. **No discount on the bus fee will be provided for one-way travel.**

The bus fee is to be paid in advance if a seat is to be secured on the bus or if the continuation of the bus service is to continue.

The Lodgment of this school bus transport application does not guarantee a seat on the bus as the school has to process the applications and numbers are limited by the capacity of the bus and scheduling capabilities of the service.

Applications for bus service will be considered if received prior to the start of the year or the start of term and not during the term.

Payment Conditions

- Transport fees will need to be paid in full before the Middle of January 2024 and in advance.
 Payment in full secures a seat to travel to and from school.
- The above fees are set fees. If a child is absent from school, no refund will be issued.
- If a cancellation happens the fees will be refunded for the remaining full school terms only.
- In case where a child has not secured a seat on the bus run for any reason, the bus fees will be refunded in full.

Terms and Conditions of travel

- Students are to always ensure that no belongings are left inside the bus.
- No items will be thrown from a bus window or have anything hanging out the window.
- Students are to always behave on the bus with no shouting in the bus while the bus is moving. so as not to distract the bus driver.
- Stay in the seat while the bus is moving.
- Get on and off the bus quietly and in an orderly manner.
- When getting off the bus only cross the road when the bus has left, and it is safe to do so.
- In the morning, arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes prior to departure.
- Students are not allowed to eat or drink while on the bus.
- Should part of the bus be damaged due to child(ren) actions the parent will be notified and liable for all damages.

Responsibilities of Parent/Caregivers

- Parents/Caregivers are responsible for transporting their children to and from authorised bus stops and their safety at the bus stop while waiting for the bus.
- It is most important that parents waiting for the bus passengers at a roadside bus stop should wait on the same side of the road of the bus to eliminate the crossing of the road by children and avoid possible accidents.
- Should your child's circumstances change that will affect your child/ren travel, please contact the school office on (02) 8769-4000.
- Transportation fees are not negotiable and must be paid by the due date.

I understand and certify that:

- All the above details are true and correct.
- I agree that if my child(ren) caused any damage to the bus, I will take full responsibility in paying the full cost of repairs or damage to the bus or its replacement if destroyed.
- Breaches of the terms and conditions of travel will result in the suspension of the bus services for my child(ren)
- I agree to abide by the above conditions of travel and undertake payment of the bus fees.
